Another important matter I wanted to update you on is the Capital Improvement Fund. As most of you know, we started this Fund to work on many projects that were included on our 5-year Capital Improvement Plan, which was mailed to you in March. To date we have raised about \$10,000, which I am most grateful for. I have enclosed with this Bulletin a report listing those who have contributed. We are asking each member, who can afford it, to donate \$100 to this fund. We encourage those who can donate more to do so in an effort to help us reach our goal of \$35,000. Any member or friend of the Knights that contributes \$500 or more will have their name listed on a plaque that will be placed in the foyer. The Plaque will have three levels of giving: Charity (\$500+), Unity (\$1,000+) and Fraternity (\$5,000+) to recognize the three main principles of our order. I would like to personally thank those who have already made a donation to the fund and encourage those that have not to please consider making a donation.
